

**15th Annual Vintage Tractor and Farm Days at the Alcouffe Community Center**

Enjoy a wonderful weekend in the beautiful Sierra foothills displaying your tractors, participating in tractor games, tractor drives and hayrides, and enjoying the many activities of Vintage Tractor and Farm Days. With more activities than ever and many vendors with food, arts and crafts, etc., this year promises to again be a wonderful family event. Come relax and enjoy.

Tractors must be a 1970 or older. Tractors should have a kill-switch, fire extinguisher, and the DMV orange triangle for slow moving vehicles. All tractors may participate in the tractor games and drives.

Exhibitors can arrive on Friday afternoon, May 3rd, to set up and get organized for the weekend. Track, steel wheel and rubber tire machines are all welcome as well as engines. RV parking will be available for only \$20 for the weekend; hook-ups are not available but there are showers available in the Community Center building. Meals will be served at the Community Center building, with a four meal packages offered at a reduced price. Food booths will also provide "fair food" type eating experiences during the day.

There are two restaurants, three RV Parks (Collins Lake, Thousand Trails and Lake Francis Resort) nearby, and the Oregon House Grocery is close for miscellaneous needs. The registration fee will be \$20/entrant (up to five machines, \$5 each for each additional) if your registration form is received **by April 27 2019**; registration fee **after April 27** will be \$25. All proceeds benefit the Dobbins-Oregon House Improvement Foundation (DOHIF) for the Alcouffe Community Center operations and improvements.
