## Welcome to the Eighth Annual Vintage Tractor Days in Dobbins/Oregon House!

The design of this event will appeal to those who want a nice place to camp, play with their tractors and engines, and enjoy a weekend in the beautiful Sierra foothills. This golf course-like facility will indeed make a fabulous memory. Last year we were blessed with close to 200 tractors registered,

Tractors must be a 1960 or older. We prefer each tractor have a "kill-switch" fire extinguisher, and the DMV requires the orange triangle for slow moving vehicles. Our experience has been that the slow moving tractors, such as Gibson and John Deere L & H, have a tough time keeping up in the parades, but we have modified our routes to accommodate these tractors on most drives. All tractors may participate in the tractor games.

The winning ticket for the famous two-tone pink 1945 Ford 2N tractor will be drawn on Saturday, May 5. One half of the raffle proceeds will go to the American Cancer Society and one half will go to the Community Center Fund.

Exhibitors can arrive on Friday afternoon, May 4, after 12:00 noon to set up and get organized for the weekend. There will be a place for track, steel wheel and rubber tire machines, as well as engines. RV parking will be available on grass with shade for only \$10/weekend. (If you wish to come earlier in the week to help Rod set up for the event, your RV fee will be waived). Hot showers are available. No hook-ups will be accessible due to county requirements. There are two restaurants, three RV Parks (Collins Lake, Thousand Trails and Lake Francis Resort) nearby, and the Oregon House Grocery is close for food, fuel, ice and spirits.

This year the registration fee will be \$15/entrant (unlimited machines) if your registration form is in **by April 20, 2012**; registration fee **after April 20** will be \$25. All proceeds will go to the Dobbins/Oregon House Improvement Foundation for their Community Center which is now open and serving our community in a variety of functions. 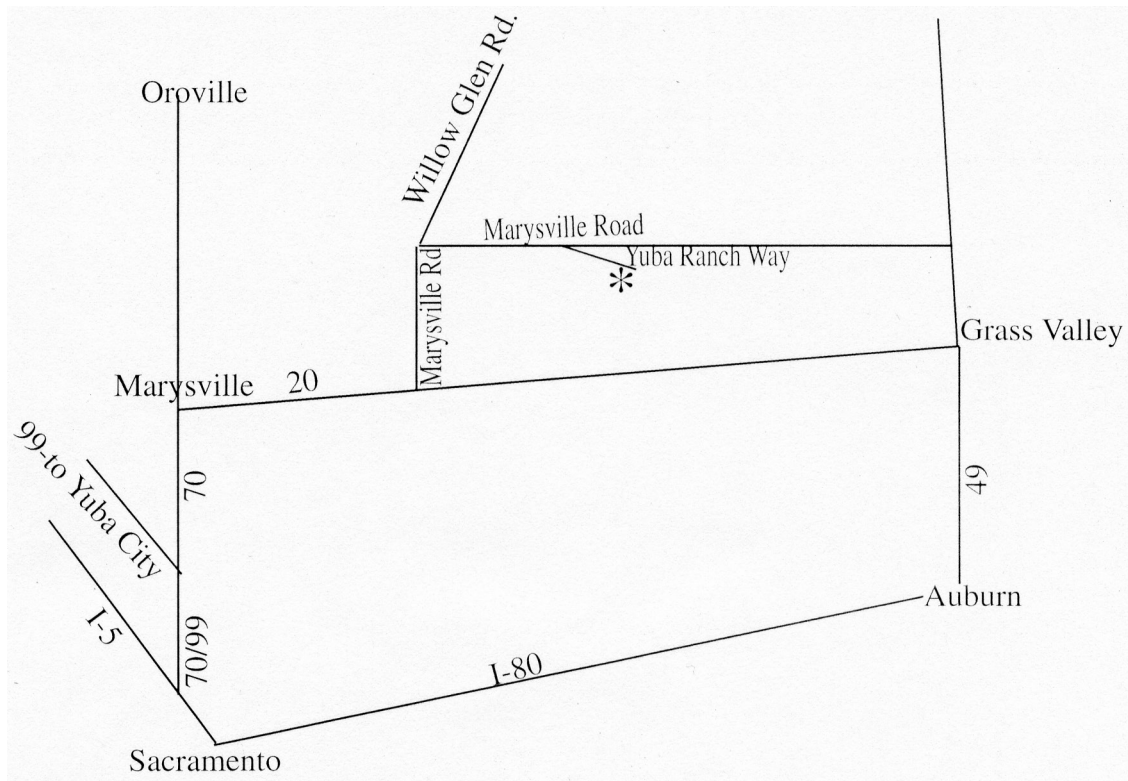

## Getting There



### Directions to Eventful Acres (10 MPH speed limit on Yuba Ranch Way)

From Reno: Take Hwy 80 West to Hwy 20 to Nevada City/Grass Valley. From Grass Valley, continue on Hwy 20 towards Marysville. At Browns Valley, turn right on Marysville Road. Stay on Marysville Road approximately 14 miles. At Willow Glen Restaurant, turn right (still on Marysville Road). About 3/4 mile past Oregon House Post Office, turn right on Yuba Ranch Way. Eventful Acres is approximately 3/4 mile on your right.

From Chico/Sacramento: From Marysville, follow Hwy 20 signs towards Grass Valley. Turn left on Marysville Road at Browns Valley. Follow above directions.
