Welcome to the Ninth Annual Vintage Tractor Days at the Alcouffe Community Center!

Enjoy a wonderful weekend in the beautiful Sierra foothills displaying your tractors, participating in tractor games and drives, and enjoying the many activities of Vintage Tractor Days. With more family activities than ever, many additional vendors with food, arts and crafts, etc., and a new venue, this year promises to be one of the best Vintage Tractor Days ever! Come, relax and enjoy.

Tractors must be a 1960 or older. Tractors should have a "kill-switch," fire extinguisher, and the DMV requires the orange triangle for slow moving vehicles. Our experience has been that the slow moving tractors, such as Gibson and John Deere L & H, have a tough time keeping up in the parades, but we have modified our routes to accommodate these tractors on most drives. All tractors may participate in the tractor games.

Exhibitors can arrive on Friday afternoon, May 3, after 3:00 PM to set up and get organized for the weekend. There will be a place for track, steel wheel and rubber tire machines, as well as engines. RV parking will be available for only \$10 for the weekend; hook-ups are not available but there are showers in the Community Center building. Meals will be served at the Community Center building, with a four meal package offered at a reduced price.

There are two restaurants, three RV Parks (Collins Lake, Thousand Trails and Lake Francis Resort) nearby, and the Oregon House Grocery is close for miscellaneous needs. As in previous years the registration fee will be \$15/entrant (unlimited machines) if your registration form is in **by April 20, 2013**; registration fee **after April 20** will be \$25. All proceeds benefit the Dobbins/Oregon House Improvement Foundation (DOHIF) for their Alcouffe Community Center operations and improvements.
