Upcoming 2013 Events

Construction Progress

This year, we kicked off a capital campaign to build a **Snack Shack** with storage and rest rooms above the ball park. Please help! If you would like to donate to this much needed improvement, see our website.

Grounds prep for Vintage Tractor Days is underway.

Park update: The Park is available to all with no charge for use on a first come first served basis. Park hours are sunup to sundown. Park use information is posted on the DOHIF website and at the facility. Short term Park area improvements include construction of a Snack Shack with restrooms and a scoreboard for the ball field. Long term improvements include installation of bleachers and outfield lighting. A capital campaign is underway to raise funds for the Snack Shack and scoreboard (fall construction start).

Building Update: We installed a new convection oven in the kitchen. With commercial kitchen certification, the kitchen is now busy with various uses. A new patio is at the South end of the building was added to serve the lounge area, wine tastings and various other events. AC/heat has now been installed in the Conference Room and Office, and our old (donated) heating/air conditioning unit for the main hall was replaced with a new high efficiency quieter unit.
